The club gained new members and raised over \$4000 at this event and sold out the Mojo 18 Lure for charity within half an hour.

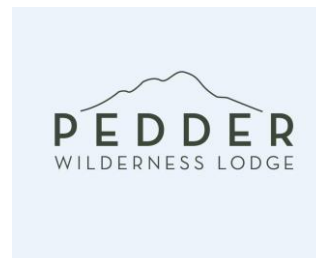
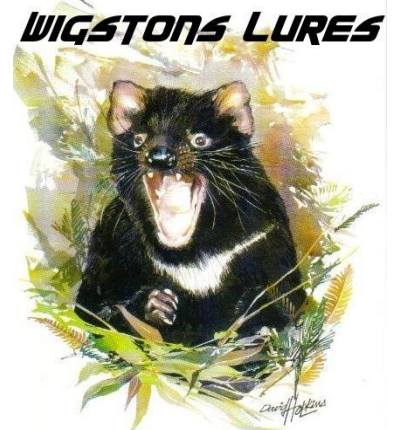
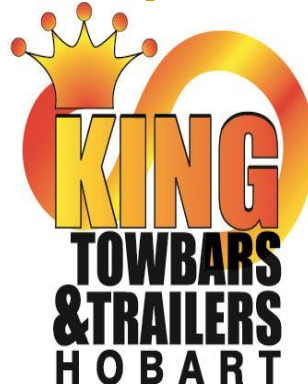
