Derwent River Intra Club Challenge

Opening Weekend 3rd and 4th August 2013

Weigh- in: New Norfolk Esplanade Rotunda 1 – 2 pm Sunday 4th August

All entrants must be in line with fish before the cut off time

Fishing is confined to the Derwent River downstream of the Meadow Dam Only trout are eligible for prizes

Heaviest trout prizes in the following categories;

Senior Male and Female
Junior – 6 to 13 years Male and Female
Junior – 14 to 17 years Male and Female

Cost for Competition is \$10.00 for adults and \$5.00 for juniors

A perpetual shield, the Derwent River Challenge shield will be awarded to the club that weighs in the five heaviest combined trout

At the weigh-in club entrants will be provided with a free BBQ. Soft drinks and other refreshments will be available for purchase.

The NNLAA will run its own internal competition over the same weekend. Entry fees from the competition will be donated to a yet named charity. A gold coin donation from all entrants would be appreciated to donate to a worthy charity.

Fisherman's Pie Draw

All entrants will go into the draw for Fisherman's Pie Prizes, consisting of top quality fishing outfits, tackle, camping gear and outdoor accessories. Persons must be present to collect prizes. If not, the prize will be redrawn.

The NNLAA will need an estimate of preliminary numbers no later than 12 noon on Friday 2nd August 2013 for catering purposes. Meat will need to be ordered on this day.

Competition Rules

- 1. Competitors enter this event at their own risk
- 2. Competitors must comply with current IFS and MAST rules and regulations. Failure to comply with these regulations may lead to disqualification
- 3. Fishing is restricted only to the Derwent River up to but not including Meadowbank Dam
- 4. Fishing may not commence prior to 12:01 am on Saturday 3rd August 2013, in line with current IFS regulations
- 5. Fish weighed in on Sunday will have their fins clipped. Therefore fish presented with clipped tail fins will not be accepted by the committee. If you need to identify fish please use another method.
- 6. Fish must be presented to the weigh master cleaned, gilled and unfrozen in a condition that is acceptable to the committee
- 7. Anglers must be in line prior to the weigh-in cut off times. Fish will not be accepted after this time.
- 8. All entrants will be entered into the Fisherman's Pie Draw. It is not necessary to catch a trout to win prizes from the draw. Once your name is drawn it will not re-enter the prize draw.
- 9. All Prizes will be awarded at the conclusion of Saturdays Weigh-in.
- 10. All decisions made by the committee are final


